College/University Applications

The deadline for applications to QUAC (University) is January 13th, and to OCAS (College) is February 1st, however, the Holy Cross recommended date is December 15th. All OUAC access numbers for university applicants have arrived and students should stop by Student Services to pick up theirs. Access numbers are not required for college applications however, students do require their OEN (Ontario Education Number) which can be found on their report card. Remote learners should contact their Guidance counsellors to receive their OUAC access number.

Quadmester 1 marks have been sent to OUAC and OCAS and students should verify their academic information in their OUAC and OCAS accounts. Students should also check to make sure their time-tables include all necessary courses for post-secondary admission.

Dual Credits at St. Lawrence College

St. Lawrence College offers Dual Credit opportunities for students to take a college course that counts for high school credit. The next term will begin in February. Contact your guidance counsellor for a list of course offerings.

Full Disclosure Date
