PASTORAL NEWS

November has been a busy month at Holy Cross, with many blessings accompanying our activities here at the school. On November 9th, we gathered in the gym for our Service of Remembrance. A big thank you to all volunteers and participants who made the service possible. On November 22nd, two grade 10 classes visited St. Mary's Cathedral and were treated to a tour by the rector, Fr. Shawn Hughes. The following week, students form the grade 11 World Religion class visited various places of worship throughout the city, including the Islamic Centre of Kingston, St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church, the Greek Orthodox Church of the Dormition of the Theotokos, and Beth Israel Synagogue.

With the start of December, our preparations for Advent are underway! The first Sunday of Advent falls on December 3rd and brings our attention to the theme of Hope. This focus leads us to anticipate not only the birth of Christ, but also to celebrate the beginning of a new liturgical year. At Holy Cross, we will be marking the beginning of each week in Advent by lighting the candles of our Advent Wreath with an accompanying liturgy of the word. College/University Applications

The deadline for applications to OUAC (Ontario Universities) is January 15th, and to OCAS (Ontario Colleges) is February 1st, however, the Holy Cross recommended date is December 15th. Students require the OEN (Ontario Education Number) which can be found on their report card. Semester 1 midterm marks have been sent to OUAC and OCAS and student should verify their academic information in their OUAC and OCAS accounts. Students should also check to make sure their timetables include all necessary courses for post-secondary admission.

Timetable Changes for Semester 2

Students intending to make changes in their Semester Two timetable are asked to so by Friday, December 15^{th} . Students can still make changes to their timetables in January, but course options are limited, therefore it is best to request changes to your timetable sooner rather than later. Students should see their guidance counsellor if they wish to discuss their timetable.






